

"Commencement" is a noun meaning a rise, origin, or first existence. It is generally a day in which degrees are publicly conferred on students who have finished collegiate education. On one day this week we had two commencements; our grandson graduated from Bible College, Praise the Lord; and a precious old saint of our church went home to be with her Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. Both were commencements, where objectives were achieved, the course was finished, and a new phase of life began. We are all pretty familiar with the commencement ceremonies for a graduate, they are a great blessing. We may be uneasy or unfamiliar calling a death and a funeral service a commencement.
