

Msg #2333 In the Beginning God, Day 1 What The Bible Says Good Samaritan's Penny Pulpit by Pastor Ed Rice Believing in the Bible's verbal inspiration, inerrancy, and infallibility requires believing God's account of his six-day creation and the seventh day of rest. Accepting any minute shred of man's evolutionary hypothesis requires that God's Holy Word is somehow deceptive. On Sunday, the first day of this universe's existence, God created, out of nothing, a finite time, space, and matter continuum. He carefully words that in the first sentence of the Holy Bible. All three continua have three dimensions, are inner dependent, and must coexist. The "earth" or "dirt" was not a planet, it was without form. He also reveals that this "matter" was void of all visible construct, massive, and dark, in his second sentence.
