Except ye be born-again, ye cannot enter the kingdom of God (John 3:1-18). "To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it" (Rev 2:17). "And he hat put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the LORD" (Ps 40:3). "Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a new song, and his praise in the congregation of saints" (Ps 149:1) "Sing unto the LORD a new song, and his praise from the end of the earth" (Isa 42:10). "Sing unto the LORD, all the earth; shew forth from day to day his salvation" (1Chr 16:23).
