The Life, Faith, and Brilliance of Blaise Pascal

On August 19, 1662, French philosopher, mathematician, and apologist Blaise Pascal died at just 39 years old. Pascal, despite his shortened life, is renowned for pioneering work in geometry, physics, and probability theory. His most powerful legacy, however, involves the ways he engaged with life's biggest questions.Pascal's intellect garnered attention at an early age. At 16, he produced an essay on the geometry of cones so impressive that René Descartes initially refused to believe it could possibly be attributed to a $\hat{a} \in \alpha$ sixteen-year-old child. $\hat{a} \in \square$ Later, Pascal advanced the study of vacuums in the face of a prevailing (and misplaced) belief that nature is completely filled with matter, and thus $\hat{a} \in \alpha$ sabors a vacuum. $\hat{a} \in \square$
